

Workshop with Catherine Gill



Thursday, Friday, Saturday, November 8-10, 2018 **9:00am – 12:30pm and 1:30pm – 4:00pm**

Catherine Gill is a very accomplished watercolor artist who teaches usually from her studio in the Pacific North-West. Her artwork has been exhibited nationally and around the world. Gill’s work has appeared in galleries and museums throughout the West Coast, New York, Canada and Japan, and she has received numerous awards. She also published an excellent instructional book “Powerful Watercolor Landscapes”.

“I prefer to work wet-in-wet for most of the painting, keeping edges soft, positives and negatives connected, and working light to dark. This method lets me paint in a simple and free way, working all over the surface, allowing me to bring the painting to a focus over a period of time. Midway through, I will let it dry, and then introduce some hard edges and fine tune it.” – Catherine Gill. Location: St. John Episcopal Church, 297 Lowell St, Newton

Cancellation, Refund and Changes:

- All cancellations must be made in writing. You may send an email (info@newtonwatercolorociety.org) or mail a letter to cancel your spot in the workshop. Mail to NWS, 876 Beacon St #1, Newton, MA 02459
- If you cancel before September 20, 2018, you will receive a refund of your tuition you have paid for the workshop; the Newton Watercolor Society will retain your \$25 deposit registration fee. If you cancel on or after September 20, 2018, you will forfeit your entire tuition for the workshop if we are unable to fill your spot.
