Newton Watercolor Society Membership Application

The NWS meets at least once a month, usually on the second Saturday of the month in the morning. The exact meeting times and locations can be found on our website's calendar page at www.newtonwatercolorsociety.org Our Annual Meeting & Potluck happens in September.

During winter on Saturdays, we arrange models to sit for figure drawing/painting, daytrips to museums or live demonstrations by local watercolorist. In spring and fall, depending on the weather, we plan outdoor plein air painting sessions at locations in our area or we meet indoors to watch a watercolor video, demo or lecture. In July and August, we take a summer break except for workshops.

Dispersed throughout the year, we arrange for at least one short and one long workshop by a master watercolorist like Charles Reid (2011), Mel Stabin (2011), Alvaro Castagnet (2012 & 2014), Paul George (2012), Joyce Hicks (2013), Joseph Zbukvic (2013), Nan Rumpf (2014) or Eric Wiegardt (2015). NWS members have an opportunity to sign up for these workshops before they are announced to the public.
