**4-day Workshop with Roberto Zangarelli**

“I know the rules, but the rules do not know me.”

Under this motto, this famous Italian watercolorist creates vibrant city and marina scenes imbued with energy and emotional intensity. Balancing between the laws of academic painting and his own vision, he creates unique, dynamic watercolor paintings that often border on the abstract. “I like to capture the essence of things, not to describe them. Through his visceral style he invites the viewer to interpret the art with their own emotional response.

Roberto Zangarelli was born in Rome in 1970. After graduating from the European Institute of Design, he founded an advertising studio and later, together with two other prominent watercolor artists, he then went on to found the Aquarelle Art Studio Association in 2016; a studio instructing watercolor techniques that convey passion and emotion by exploring the unpredictability of watercolor.

Roberto Zangarelli is a European master aquarellist, well known in Europe and all over the world. Over the last several years he has been invited to national and international exhibitions and events in Shenzhen (China), Pakistan, Hungary, France, Belgium, India, Italy, and Russia. He regularly hosts watercolor courses and workshops in Rome and all over Europe, and is coming to the US for the first time to us in Newton. This is an indoor workshop and we will be painting urban scenes and marina landscapes. This workshop is for intermediate to advanced watercolor artists.
