Materials List

Use the materials you already have and are comfortable with. Here are just some suggestions:

- **Sketchbook** for notes, compositional drawings and value studies.
- Watercolor paper: Your choice of <u>rough</u>, <u>cold press</u>, hot <u>press</u> whatever you want to try. Arches 140 lb is a good choice, but if you like a different brand you can use it as long as it is good quality paper. You can try special papers like <u>Yupo</u>, <u>rice and masa</u> paper. We will be doing a <u>minimum</u> of **2** paintings each week. Recommended size is 1/2 sheet.
- Watercolor Brushes: You will need large and small brushes, such as 1-1/2" flat, 1/2" flat, #12 round, #8 round. Having a large brush is important as we will be painting large.
- Watercolor paints: Use watercolor tube colors that you already have by any company

• Miscellaneous:

- O White palette with cover, paper towels, drawing pencils, eraser, tracing paper, stiff backing board for attaching your paper, artists tape
- O Stencils or anything that can create texture. Most of this can be collected around your house. For example, alcohol, salt, plastic wrap, wax paper, bubble wrap, comb and other stencils, crayon, charcoal, candle or wax for resist. You don't need everything at the first meeting
- Paper for collaging like tissue paper, newspaper, etc.
- Masking fluid (optional)
